SPECIAL VOTING

Special voting in terms of the Local Electoral Act 2001 and the Local Electoral Regulations 2001 may be exercised at the above council office and times.

A person can apply to enrol as either a residential or ratepayer elector right up to and including 11 October 2013 – the day before the close of voting.

ORDER OF CANDIDATE NAMES ON VOTING DOCUMENTS

The Ashburton Licensing Trust has resolved under regulation 31 of the Local Electoral Regulations 2001 to adopt the pseudo-random order of candidate names to appear on the voting documents. Candidate names were randomly drawn out of a hat by a Justice of the Peace on 17 August 2013.
