# Sauvignon Blanc

## **Montana Festival Block** *(Marlborough)*

This wine displays aromas of tomato leaf, red capsicum and lemongrass. The palate is alive with pineapple and freshly cut herbs with a zesty finish

## **Astrolabe** *(Marlborough)*

Beautiful aroma of lemon grass, lime peel and elderflower. Medium-bodied with currant, gooseberry and citrus flavours, and a dry mineral finish

## **Jules Taylor** *(Marlborough)*

A delightful light lime colour, this wine shows evolving aromas of passionfruit, citrus, jalapeño pepper and currant leaf. Rich flavours of tropical and citrus fruits on the palate are complemented by fresh herbaceous notes.

## **Stoneleigh Latitude** *(Marlborough)*

The array of pungent flavours can include ripe and juicy tropical fruits or follow a more herbaceous style with chopped capsicum, citrus and grassy overtones.

# Chardonnay

## **Montana Festival Block** *(Hawkes Bay)*

Lifted aromas of peaches, apricots and pineapples characterize this unoaked Chardonnay with clean, fresh acidity on the palate balanced by the richness of ripe fruit

## **Church Road McDonald Series** *(Hawkes Bay)*

A richly textured Chardonnay full of character, yet finely textured with a long, flavoursome finish. Aromas of white flowers mingle with peach and melon to accompany a delicious nuttiness on the palate

## **Brookfields Bergman** *(Hawkes Bay)*

Rich in stone-fruit with subtle oak due to its barrel fermentation in a mixture of French and American barriques. There is stonefruit, a hint of citrus, and length on the palate

A complex bouquet of subtle spice and toasted brioche, white peach, nectarine, poor mans orange , and almond meal. The palate is tight, layered and focused, with a dense texture, concentrated fruit and a salivating president mineral finish

## **Braided Rivers Pinot Gris** (*Canterbury*)

Braided River Pinot Gris is made from carefully selected handpicked grapes. This is a complex aromatic Pinot Gris, made in an off dry style

Displays delicate pear and peach characters with a touch of flintiness, a creamy texture and tantalising spice notes

## **Braided Rivers Riesling** (*Canterbury*)

A dry Canterbury Riesling made from carefully selected handpicked grapes. This wine has gentle, but enticing, floral aromas, delicious citrus flavours and layers of complexity.

Central Otago's affinity for Riesling is shown with her with intensely clear lime and floral notes, and a focused, satisfying palate.

# Pinot Noir

## **The Maker 'Fire Eagle' Petite Pinot** *(Marlborough/Gisborne)*

Packed with ripe cherries and red fruits from the Pinot and supported with bold sweet Merlot notes

## **Stoneleigh Latitude Pinot Noir** *(Marlborough)*

This wine presents blackberry, toasty oak and mocha aromas on the nose. The palate offers dark red fruits, blackcurrant and boysenberry with strawberry undertones complemented by some savoury oak

## **Gibbston Valley 'Gold River' Pinot Noir** *(Central Otago)*

Excellent bright Pinot Noir flavours with layers of dark cherry, spice and a harmonious finish.

## **Black Estate Pinot Noir** *(Waipara)*

A complex bouquet with brambly dark fruits, exotic spice, fresh earth, and broken chalk. The palate is supple, elastic and dense. Velvet like. Origins of chalky soil emerge by way of a crisp and freshening mineral finish

## Other Reds – New Zealand

### **Villa Maria Organic Merlot** (*Hawkes Bay*)

Bright, deep crimson hues lead to a vibrant nose of red plum and berry fruits with subtle cedary undertones. A full, textured palate with soft tannins makes this an excellent food wine

### **Brookfields Sundried Malbec** (*Hawkes Bay*)

Elevated blackcurrant fruit underpinned with firm tannins and silky oak

### **Church Road McDonald Series Merlot** (*Hawkes Bay*)

Fragrant and appealing, this wine exudes rich, dark berry and plum fruits, fragrant violet notes and a touch of spice. This is a sensuous and ripe Hawkes Bay Merlot

### **Passage Rock ‘The Sisters’ Cabernet Merlot** (*Waiheke Island*)

Passage Rock wines is the holder of more awards and medals than any other Waiheke Island Winery. Cabernet dominated, medium-bodied Bordeaux blend and spiced with a little Syrah, smooth and ready to drink. Flavours of violets, berry fruits, cassis, liquorice, vanilla and oak

### **Esk Valley “The Terraces”** (*Hawkes Bay*)

The wine is very deeply coloured and full of primary black fruits including cherry and blackberry. As a young wine, French oak notes complement the fruit, but with age, complexity and vineyard nuances will predominate

## Other Reds – Australia

### **George Wyndham Founders Reserve Shiraz** (*South Australia*)

A rich full palate of spicy plum flavours balanced with well-integrated oak. Elegant wine with soft, well structured tannins and a lingering finish

### **Jim Barry Cover Drive Cabernet Sauvignon** (*Clare Valley, South Australia*)

A generous, medium bodied palate with lovely succulent tannins which carry the flavours of blackcurrant, sandalwood, liquorice and morello cherries

### **Wolf Bass Black Label Cabernet Sauvignon Shiraz** (*Barossa Valley, South Australia*)
